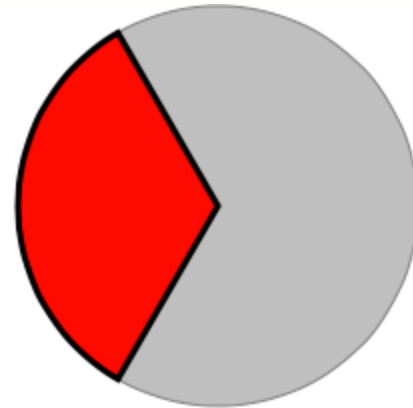

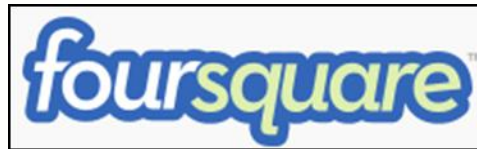

Using Open Badges

► Uses of digital badges

Issuers use badges for:

- college or secondary school courses
- camp or seasonal activity
- recreational activity
- employee training
- professional credentialing
- personalized learning

Recipients seek badges for:

- creating a record of accomplishment
- accumulating badges to demonstrate expertise
- displaying badges to represent participation in events
- sharing with potential employers or admissions offices

Using Open Badges

Open badges

Open Badges are:

- **Free and open:** Mozilla Open Badges is free software and an open technical standard any organization can use to create, issue and verify digital badges.
- **Transferable:** Collect badges from multiple sources, online and off, into a single backpack. Then display your skills and achievements on social networking profiles, job sites, websites and more.
- **Stackable:** Whether they're issued by one organization or many, badges can build upon each other and be stacked to tell the full story of your skills and achievements.
- **Evidence-based:** Open Badges have important metadata hard-coded into each badge image that links back to the issuer, criteria and verifying evidence.

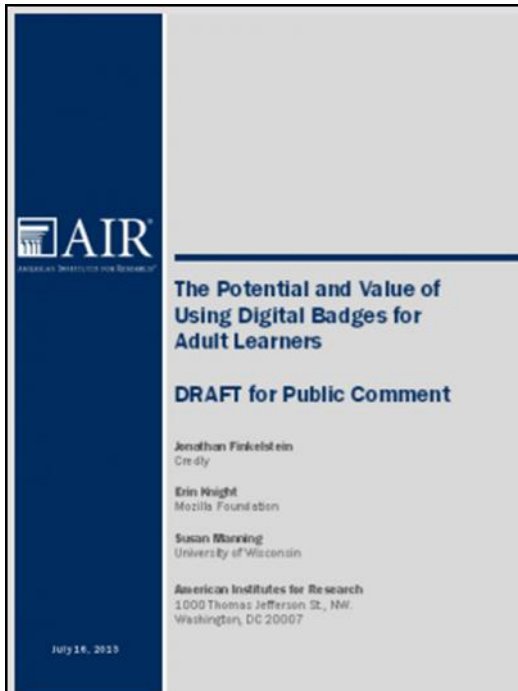

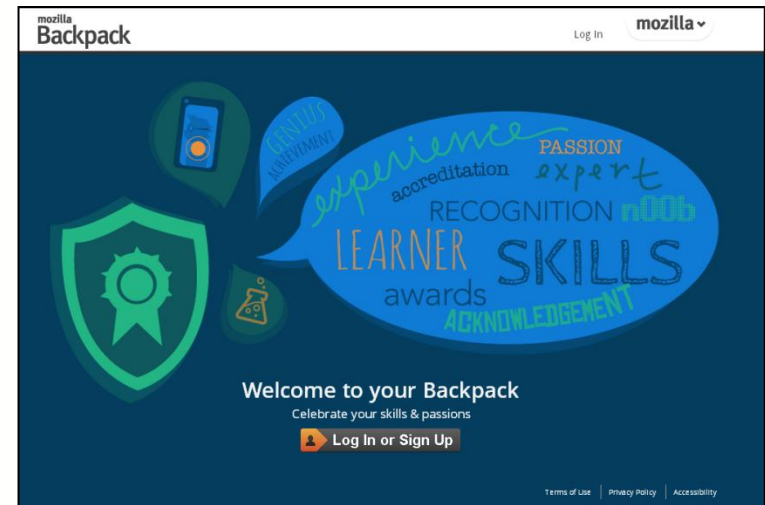
► Open Badges Infrastructure

Open Badges Specifications

A repository for the main Open Badges specifications.

- **Assertion:** Main specification for the badge data. If you want to understand how badges are made and verified, this is the place to look.
- **Baking:** Badge "baking" is the process of embedding a badge assertion into an image (a PNG or an SVG) so that where ever that image goes, the assertion data goes with it and the badge can be independently verified.
- **Backpack [TODO]:** A badge "backpack" is a web site/application that can take in & export badges. The Open Badges JavaScript API expects endpoints to be in specific or discoverable locations, and this document details that.
